Descriptif	The course is a general survey of the discipline of IR's main theories and concepts, as well as a brief outline of the history of world politics since World War One. It proposes an intellectual history of the academic discipline of IR as situated in the evolution of the world political context. The objective pursued is to give students the tools permitting them to form their own rigorous analyses about how world politics works and why it works the way it works, to incite them to go beyond commonsense discourses and normatively biased or ideologically oriented assessments of world politics typical of politicians' speeches, experts' comments, and media coverage.
