On the basis of these topics: reinforcing the students' command of basic linguistic skills; developing their lexical and syntactic skills; developing their ability to speak at length; oral interaction.

Recommended Prerequisite(s)

A2 + level.

A good command of the basic linguistic tools: Syntax of nominal sentences and verbal sentences, verb conjugation in all tenses and moods, isolated pronouns and affixes, correct agreements, nominal and verbal morphology, negation (nominal and verbal sentences), completive markers (of purpose, of cause).
